Race Summary

WEST TO DURANGO settled early three or four wide, edged up between horses on the turn, moved six or seven wide into the stretch, took over leaving the eighth pole and was hard ridden the remainder. FIVE STAR THIEF, within striking distance and five or six wide, moved with the winner while outside that one entering the stretch and was second best. FOXIE'S BOY drifted out while breaking well, quickly was angled in to make the pace three wide, held on well until the final furlong and weakened grudgingly. STORM FORCE, in a striking position throughout and between foes four wide, was empty late. CRAFTY KID, six or seven wide most of the way, failed to offer a serious late bid. GRAND SURVIVAL, within easy striking distance and between foes three or four wide, was empty when straightened into the stretch. SISTER BAY, well placed inside to the lane, weakened thereafter. HOHO TOW forced the pace to the head of the stretch and gradually weakened.
